




When You Feel All Alone-Part 2



When you became a born-again believer in Jesus, you received a promise from Him that you will live forever with Him, and that love, joy and peace are your inheritance in Him. This promise is the power of God in you.


It is yours forever and no one has the power to take it away from you, but if you are not careful to keep it always in your mind it is very easy to change the feeling of love toward someone into dislike; the feeling of joy into sadness; and the feeling of peace into fear when unexpected trials and troubles come your way, especially if you're feeling all alone.



The bad feelings make you feel alone, but they are just feelings, and they are not from Jesus. The Bible promises that you are never alone because when you believe in Jesus you become one with Him! *"The person who is united to the Lord becomes one spirit with Him."* 1 Corinthians 6:17

But, we have an enemy called "the devil" who tries to steal the faith in Jesus from every believer, through fear and doubt. Paul, the Apostle, wrote these words to believers who were afraid: *"_ _ become strong in the Lord, be empowered through your union with Him; draw your strength from Him so that you may be able successfully to stand up against all the deceptions of the devil and having done all the crisis demands, to stand firmly in your place."* Ephesians 6:10-13

Jesus gave you power over all the devil, when He spoke these words: *power (physical and mental strength enemy possesses and nothing shall*



works of your physical and spiritual enemy, the *"Behold, I have given you authority and ability) over all the power that the in any way harm you."* Luke 10:19 AMP

The power that has been given to you problem, any sickness, any your faith, and even any mistakes you affect your life deeply. In other words, you have within you, because of Jesus, the potential to overcome any obstacle you are facing now, or will ever face.

Potential is power that you have within you that has not been used yet. You use that power when you stand alone in the face of adversity – standing strong when you realize that you are not alone after all, because Jesus is there with you and has already given you the victory over the circumstance, whatever it is.



Don't surrender your power to any person or circumstance. The person or thing you fear has power over you if you let them. The person you refuse to forgive has power over you to make you think on hurtful things of the past instead of living in love, joy and peace.

Whatever hurtful things happened in the past – even rape, incest, abuse, abandonment – it doesn't have the power to cripple you now unless you give it the power by remembering it over and over. It was bad enough to live through once, why live it over again and again? No matter how bad it was, it does not have the power to hurt you now, unless you give it the power.

Jesus said that nothing that happens to your body from the outside can make you unclean – only wrong thoughts and desires that come from your own heart can make you unclean. Let your past be your strength – not your weakness – for it is overcoming the past that has made you who you are.

If the devil stole some yesterdays from you, don't give him your todays because of it. The way he steals from you is by making you doubt your inheritance in Jesus. The devil is the root of the problems you have. If he can make you doubt God's love when adversity comes, he will steal your power and leave you feeling weak, afraid and alone.



The pain of your yesterdays is a small thing compared to your new life as a child of God; accepted into His family; made into a joint heir with His beloved Son, Jesus; given all the blessings of heaven that are yours forever; and promised that no one can take you away from Him: *“My sheep hear my voice and I know them, and they follow Me, and I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. I and My Father are one.”* John 10:27-30 NKJ

The Bible sums it all up with these beautiful words: *“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials that your faith, being much more precious than gold, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom having not seen, you love, and receiving the end of your faith – the salvation of your soul.”* 1 Peter 1:3-9

When you have Jesus – you will never have to feel alone again because you are loved with an everlasting love! He will never leave you! His promise is true, only believe!
